Riko Debenjak: Surway exhibition

9 Aug - 11 Nov, International Centre of Graphic Arts

Riko Debenjak (1908-1987) established himself as a leading representative of contemporary colour experimental printmaking. The beginning of Debenjak's "classical" work in printmaking is marked by the year 1953. The exhibition is dedicated to the 110th anniversary of the artist's birth. Also displayed along with the graphic prints are the artist's other works: drawings, paintings, illustrations and printing plates. The exhibition was produced in cooperation with the Debenjak family, the Kanal ob Soči Riko Debenjak Gallery and the Museum of Modern Art.

Stojan Kerbler - retrospective

25 Oct - 27 Jan 2019, Museum of Modern Art

Stojan Kerbler is one of the main figures in the field of Slovene photography over last fifty years. The present retrospective covers a wide range of Kerbler's works, from the late 1950s to the early 1990s and illustrates the master photographer's search for a suitable photographic idiom, the changes in and development of his photographic expression that were the result of his uncompromising vision and his humanity as well as his inner development, which in turn well serve to illustrate the inner logic of his changes in style and subject matter. The exhibition features 174 photographs, a showcase of a rich selection of magazines, catalogues and other publications with contributions on Kerbler's work, as well as two documentaries about the photographer.

To mark its one hundredth anniversary, the National Gallery of Slovenia presents the life and work of Ivana Kobilca, one of the most well-known Slovenian artists of all times. Together with her friends and acquaintances like Rosa Pfäffinger, Maria Slavona and Käthe Kollwitz, she was one of the first female painters of the modern age that succeeded in a traditionally male field.

Her first retrospective in forty years will present around 130 works of art from all periods and of different genres. Besides popular works, like *Woman Drinking Coffee*, *Summer*, *Children in Grass* and *Mira Pintar*, many lesser-known paintings will be presented; together, the pictures reflect Kobilca's creative power and the influences of European art centres.

Let's Celebrate Together. Hundred Years of the National Gallery of Slovenia

4 Aug - 4 Nov, Tivoli Park, Jakopič Promenade

On the 18th of September, 1918, the National Gallery Society was founded - having neither art holdings or exhibition space nor financial assets, but furnished with a lot of zeal. The palace of Narodni Dom became its home in 1925, and since 1933 an extensive permanent art collection has been exhibited in it. Thirteen years later the Gallery became a state institution and a home for all of us.

Displayed along the Jakopič Promenade in Tivoli Park are details of works of art from the Gallery's permanent collection which was considerably expanded after the renovation of the palace of Narodni Dom in 2016. To recognize them as creations of our artists means to belong to the Slovenian community, to participate in its happy and less happy days with that creative willpower that brought into existence the National Gallery of Slovenia.

The Švicarija: Community, Art and Nature Project

8 Feb 2018 - 6 Jan 2019, Švicarija Creative Centre

The Švicarija: Community, Art and Nature Project encompasses a multifaceted exhibition and a year-long programme of events linking the past with the new vision of the Švicarija Creative Centre. Drawing from the diverse history of the building, the meeting space of various models of coexistence and cooperation, as well as the specific environment of domesticated nature, the building of Švicarija is imbued by reflection on history, architecture and

art. The exhibition was produced by International Centre of Graphic Arts in cooperation with the Institute for the Protection of Cultural Heritage of Slovenia, the City Museum of Ljubljana and the Arrea Architecture Bureau.

Zoran Mušič (1909-2005)

Permanent exhibition at the National Gallery

Zoran Mušič, the best known 20th century Slovenian-born painter and a man with more than one homeland, spent most of his life between Venice and Paris. He mostly painted landscapes, still lifes, portraits, Dalmatian donkeys and horses, trees, views of Venice, double portraits with his wife Ida, and poignant self-portraits depicting him as an old man. His visual motifs were always related to the Slovenian region of Kras and its typical scenes. He became world famous with his series of paintings We Are Not the Last, in which he relived the scenes he experienced in the Dachau concentration camp. Ljubljana's National Gallery displays the world's only permanent survey exhibition of Mušič's work, which explores the entire range of the famous artist's painting techniques.

Plečnik Collection

The new permanent exhibition at the Plečnik House in Trnovo presents the most important projects of the late architect. Plečnik's creativity comes to life through the plans, models and photographs of his creations such as the Zacherl House in Vienna, Prague Castle, the National and University Library in Ljubljana, the Ljubljana Central Market, Žale Cemetery, the Church of St. Michael at the Ljubljana Marshes and numerous other masterpieces. Several plans of Plečnik's never realized visions are also on display. The Cathedral of Freedom, the master's vision of the Slovenian parliament, is especially worthy of our attention.

Permanent exhibition at the City Museum of Ljubljana

A new permanent exhibition about the history of Ljubljana. How well do you know the rich history of Slovenian capital? Pile-dwellers, Emona, Middle and New Ages, the 20th and 21st centuries... what is the history of Ljubljana? A chronological presentation of Ljubljana's millennia of heritage with precious authentic artefacts, like the world's oldest wooden wheel with an axle, is now on display on Ljubljana. History. City. exhibition. In our globalised world, heritage just might be what differentiates cities the most, and it also shaped our capital's identity. Therefore, the exhibition proudly highlights local peculiarities, stories of everyday life in the past, and the individuals who left the strongest impressions on our history. Open: 10:00 - 18:00, Thursdays until 21:00. Closed: Mondays

Prestigious exhibition of original artfully made jewellery, tableware, and other items of artistic merit. The gold items from the imperial treasury of the Ming dynasty, more precisely, from the Wanli period (1573-1620), are great masterpieces of gold crafts, and they show the sophisticated taste as well as the economic power of the famous rulers. Jewellery, tableware, and other items of artistic merit show the social position of their owners, while depictions of dragons with five claws and phoenixes reveal connections with the imperial family. These items rarely leave China and can be seen in Slovenia for the first time. Open daily: 10:00 - 18:00, Thursdays 10:00-20:00
